**Trauma is the leading cause of death age 1-44 in the
United States and bleeding is responsible
for 35-40% of deaths in first 24 hours!**

**Learning what to do while waiting for
first responders to arrive can save lives!**

**B-Con is designed for laypeople with no medical training
in response to active shooter and mass casualty events,
but skills learned can be used in the event of
ANY life-threatening bleeding!**

B-Con teaches basic life-saving interventions including:

- Recognition of life-threatening bleeding
- Bleeding control with a commercial or improvised tourniquet
- Wound-packing using hemostatic gauze
 - And much more!
